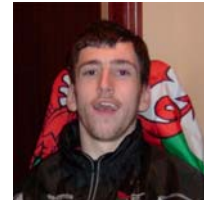


Removing Red Eye

Open File: New: Gimp Images: Red Eye on your memory stick.



Click on to the Ellipse select icon (immediately under Xtns) and draw a tiny circle around one eye. Go to Filters: Enhance: Red eye removal and click OK. Repeat on the other eye. You may need to magnify your photo before removing red eye – if so, click on View: Zoom and select the ratio.



Saving an image

To save as a Jpeg, click on File: Save a copy. If you want a different format, go to Save as, select your format and follow the instructions through.

These are only a few examples of manipulations using Gimp. You may add text; create logos, save your designs as html for creating web pages, extract objects/people and paste them on to a new background..... And more! Can you turn the tulips yellow or, even more of a challenge, change the colour of each one separately?
